This is an update and replaces all previous memos. It is intended to keep all of you informed and to particularly assist [Edited] and Mom (my Personal Representative, and in case of our common death or disability, [Edited]) handle my affairs should I become disabled, or estate matters upon my death, or Mom's and my estate matters in the event of our common incapacity and/or death.

**SHOULD I, or MOM and I BECOME DISABLED:**

1. Mom's and my doctor is [edited], MD, an internal medicine partner at [Edited]- 770.[edited], [edited], [Edited], GA 30[edited]. This is just outside the [Edited] entrance. He has all of our medical records, as well as copies of Mom's and my *Georgia Advance Directive for Health Care*.  
Our original *Wills*, and *Georgia Advance Directives for Health Care* are in the [Edited] Bank Safety Deposit Box (see major topic SAFETY DEPOSIT BOX below). I have granted Mom power and if she is unable to act, [Edited] is to act. Mom has granted me power and if I am unable to act, [Edited] is to act. Also each of you couples have copies of our current wills.
2. Details of our financial records, cash assets available, life/ADD and long-term care insurance, bills and assets follow under those major topics.

**IMMEDIATELY UPON MY DEATH (Same applies in event of Mom's and my common death):**

1. If I die at home, call 911. When [Edited] County Fire & Rescue arrives, they will confirm my death. **Tell them I am an organ and tissue donor.** Ask them to call [Edited] Funeral Home- 770.[edited]. If my organs and/or tissue are needed, F&R will take my body to [Edited]for "harvesting." [Edited] Funeral Home will pick up my body from [Edited]. If my organs and/or tissue are not needed, [Edited] Funeral Home will pick up my body from our home. [Edited] Funeral Home cannot pick up my body until F&R- certifies my death.

5. If Mom has also died or is disabled, move the items below to secure locations:

  - † the cash envelope in [edited]

## VERY SOON AFTER MY DEATH:

### SOON AFTER MY DEATH:

1. **READING OF MY WILL** or in the event of our common death, **OUR WILLS:**

I recommend you not remove the original will(s) from the Safe Deposit Box until you are ready to file for probate. Instead, take the copy in [edited], make a copy of the will(s) for each person present (at parents' discretion) so he/she can follow along as the will(s) is read. Afterwards, it is my desire that the conversation focus on God— His grace, His mercy, His provision, His love, His . . . .
2. Mom and I have made advance cremation arrangements with *[Edited]*'s *Funeral Home*. Since Mom and I are *Memorial Society of Georgia* (770.634.2896) members, *[Edited]* *F.H.* owner *[Edited]* has agreed to charge the then current *M. S. of G.* rate for "a simple cremation container" (presently "not greater than \$895.00"). Inform *[Edited]* that we do not want any paid-for biographical obituary. The simple standard death notice in the [edited], [edited], and/or Atlanta newspaper(s) will be sufficient. Ask [edited]'s to provide [edited] fifteen (15) certified copies of the Death Certificate, and an American flag for Mom.

Please invite to participate: TE *[Edited]*- 770.[edited]; James "Hoonie" Lee- 678.[edited] cell/404.[edited] home; *[Edited]*, [edited]; *[Edited]*, [edited]; and *[Edited]*- 678.[edited] cell. *[Edited]* or *[Edited]* should prepare the honorarium checks (from *Operating* check book- the blue cover) and simple *Thank You* notes (center office desk drawer) for Mom's signature. Pastor *[Edited]* will give you guidance on the amount of each honorarium. His honorarium should be the largest.
5. Also, you can also decide among yourselves about having a family celebration several weeks out, during which my ashes can be disposed of (i.e. sprinkling them in the Gulf offshore from [edited], or in Lake Lanier, or in the [edited] mountains, etc.) The expenses for this family gathering are to be paid from my estate. Make it a celebration. Have a party! Dad is/Mom and Dad are HOME!

**DURING THE NEXT WEEK OR SO, MOM and [EDITED], ASSISTED by [EDITED]:**

1. Notify *Social Security Admin.*- 800.325.0778, website: *www.ssa.gov*. The representative will tell you where to send a certified death certificate. SSA will .[edited] and .[edited].
2. Notify the [Edited]- [edited] to stop my [edited], and start Mom's [edited]. [Edited] papers are in very front of bottom drawer of filing cabinet left of my desk.
3. Ask [Edited] to meet with Mom, [Edited] & [Edited], [Edited] & [Edited], [Edited] & [Edited] about how "best" to change ownership(s) of the various bank accounts (i.e. Mom alone, Mom and all children jointly, Mom and ???), and the investment accounts (i.e. Mom alone, with [Edited] & [Edited], [Edited] & [Edited], [Edited] & [Edited] as contingent beneficiaries; Mom and ???).

  - † Have [Edited] *Bank* remove my name from A/Cs #[edited] (used for [edited] and as a convient depository until we ETF funds into our Family [edited]), and [edited]. Since [Edited] already has access to the Safety Deposit Box, I recommend [Edited] and [Edited] also be granted access. The bank will probably need one (1) certified death certificate.

  - † Notify *T. Rowe Price*- 800.638.5660. Mom and I have A/C #[edited] we use as a Reserve for Depreciation. See **CASH ASSETS AVAILABLE: T. Rowe Price** below. The telephone representative will help you process these changes. *TRP* will probably need one (1) certified death certificate. Details are in white [edited] notebook and the white ESTATE PAPERS notebook in [edited]
  - † Notify *The Vanguard Fund*- 800.662.2739. Mom and I have A/C [edited] we also use as a Reserve for Depreciation. See **CASH ASSETS AVAILABLE: The Vanguard Group** below. The telephone representative will help you process these changes. Vanguard will probably need one (1) certified death certificate. Details are in white [edited] notebook and the white ESTATE PAPERS notebook in [edited]

6. Both Mom and I have Federal Long Term Care Insurance coverage provided by *Long Term Care Partners, LLC*, 100 Arboretum Drive, Suite 100, Portsmouth, NH 03801-7833, 800.843.337. Notify them to cancel my policy. The original policy is in the [Edited] Safe Deposit Box, with a copy in INSURANCE- Long Term Care in top drawer of the office filing cabinet. They will probably not need a death certificate.
7. Notify [Edited]- 800.[edited] of my death. The Auto, Homeowners and Umbrella policies will probably have to be switched from my [edited] #[edited] to Mom's #[edited]. Auto insurance on the [edited] **should not be canceled until it is sold.**
8. Notify all Credit Card issuers to delete my name on their accounts, retaining appropriate accounts in name of [edited]. (Credit Card file is in bottom drawer of the filing cabinet next to my desk.) Remember, the *CITI Driver Edge* card carries points which may be redeemed toward purchase of ANY new or used automobile. After consulting with Mom, cancel unnecessary cards (i.e. *Home Depot, Kohl's, Delta Frequent Flyer, etc.*) No death certificates will be needed.

#### **PROBATE:**

1. To begin the probate process, take my **original will** (from the [Edited] Safety Deposit Box) to the [Edited] County Probate Court at [edited] in downtown [Edited], telephone 770.[edited] ext. [edited]. You will be given the probate fee schedule and the proper forms to be filled out and returned. **Do not engage an attorney** to probate my will unless there are significantly unusual circumstances I cannot envision. **Discuss this fully with [edited] before engaging an attorney.** If you do decide to talk with an attorney, be certain you fully understand the fee schedule. Most often, attorney's probate fees are a percentage of the **gross estate**, and not determined by the complexity or amount of work involved. Attorney [Edited]- 770.[edited] prepared our original wills.
2. To transfer title to [edited] to Mom, you may be able to do this by going to the [Edited] County Court House. This is a very simple and routine matter. If you need a [Edited] County attorney, the fee should be nominal. Call our Realtor, [Edited]- 770.[edited] for an attorney recommendation. The original *Deed* is in the Safety Deposit Box (see below),
3. Then instruct [Edited]- 800.[edited] (Mortgage Loan #[edited]) and [Edited] Bank 800.[edited] to remove my name from the mortgage and the home equity line. They will probably require copies of documentation that my name has been removed from the *Deed*. The mortgage and home equity line *Notes* are in the Safety Deposit Box.

This lie is so broadly accepted, most of our Christian and non-Christian friends alike believe it. But we must not! We are God's stewards, and as His stewards, we must one day give God an accounting of our stewardship.

And that leads to the point— we are all passing through this life. I have written this memo because I recognize that I shall go to be with the LORD. And much of the property God has placed under Mom's and my stewardships will pass to your stewardships to be managed along with that which is already in your care. So praise God for His Godness, thank Him for His goodness and for His abundant grace and mercy to us. Enjoy the "harvest" God provides you. But be careful that you, "Eat the eggs but don't eat the goose that lays them."

With this firmly in mind, it is my heartfelt desire that you receive whatever of God's resources He entrusts to your care for a time, always mindful they are His resources. Manage them as wise stewards. From their increase, return to the LORD His tithe and your offering. Reinvest a good portion and use the remainder as you think the LORD would have you . . . and all with praise and thanksgiving. By so doing, "the goose will continue providing eggs" for you and for generations which follow. Okay!?!?

On the page following, the FINANCIAL RECAP shows the income sources available to Mom based upon values at 03/31/08. I recommend *[Edited]* manage the life insurance proceeds, the IRAs, and other investment assets to earn an appropriate return. Mom should be able to live comfortably. When we are both with the LORD, the "goose" will pass to you couples who will pass it to yours who will pass it to theirs who will pass it to . . .

**Finally, always remember how grateful I am to God for each of you. He has blessed me above measure. I am, of all men, most blessed! I love you, and commend you to the tender mercies of God . . . and look forward to our glorious reunion "on the other side."**
